For passport applications, complete your application on e-citizen <a href="https://ecitizen.go.ke/">https://ecitizen.go.ke/</a>, download and print the application form, invoices and attach all required documents.

Details on requirements for all the services are on our website; <u>www.embassyofkenya.it</u> - click on 'Consular.'

For Kenya National Identity Card Registration; all applicants will require 3 passport photos taken on a white background (3.5cm\*4.5cm), original and copy of birth certificate, original and copy of valid Kenyan passport, copy of kenyan identity card of either parent, original 1st generation ID for holders of the 1st generation ID, € 50 application fees.

For Lost/ Duplicate/Mutilated Identity Card; copy of police report/notarized affidavit, original & copy of valid kenyan passport, original & copy of birth certificate, copy of lost ID (if available), original ID (for duplicate/mutliated ID), € 50 application fees.

NOTE:- Fees for all consular services 'except' passports should be paid through;
